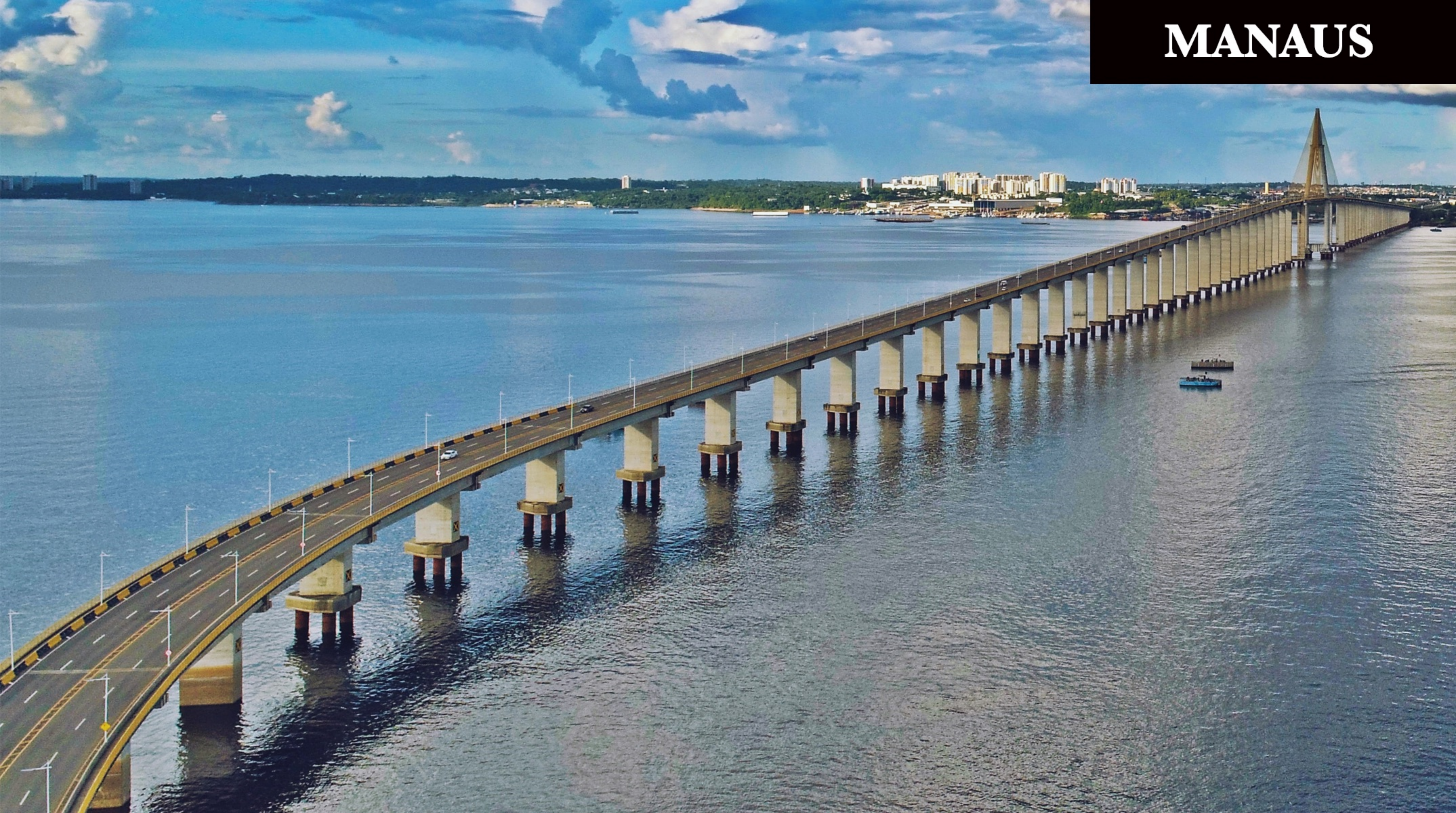

DAY 3 - Thursday | 28th January 2027

Activities: The Magic & Soul of Salvador (Half-day City Tour)

Step into the heart of Brazil's most mystical and soul-stirring city. Salvador is a land of legends - it's where music, mysticism and magic dance through the streets. After breakfast, we'll set out on a half-day historical tour that begins in the scenic Barra District, where the Atlantic meets the Bay of All Saints. We'll visit the iconic Farol da Barra lighthouse, a dramatic sentinel guarding the bay's entrance. From there, we travel back in time as we enter the cobbled streets of Pelourinho, the UNESCO-listed historic center bursting with colonial charm, colourful facades and Afro-Brazilian energy.

A true highlight awaits inside the Cathedral Basilica of Salvador, a breathtaking example of baroque architecture and sacred beauty.

In the evening, the city comes alive with rhythm and tradition. You'll enjoy a captivating Folklore Show, where Bahia's cultural soul takes center stage through dance and mystic rituals, paired with a traditional dinner. Truly a night of flavours, stories and spiritual flair you won't forget.

DAY 4 - Friday | 29th January 2027

Activities: Free day in Salvador

We may also take optional day tours at an extra cost by boat to Praia do Forte, Guarajuba Beach and Morre de Sao Paulo.

In the evening, you can enjoy the Bahia Carnival all night long.

DAY 5 - Saturday | 30th January 2027

Activities: From Salvador to Manaus (Amazonia)

DAY 6 - Sunday | 31st January 2027

Activities: Into the Wild – Canoe Tour & Piranha Fishing

After breakfast, we leave the city behind and head deep into the Amazon. A scenic journey by road and river (around 2 hours) brings us to the Amazon Ecopark Jungle Lodge, nestled in the lush embrace of the rainforest. Upon arrival, we're greeted with welcome drinks and a delicious lunch - the perfect start to our jungle adventure.

In the afternoon, we set out on a guided canoe tour, gliding through winding waterways surrounded by vibrant flora and the sounds of the forest. Then, test your skills (and nerve!) with a round of piranha fishing - a thrilling local tradition.

As the sun sets over the Amazon, we return to the lodge for dinner, sharing stories from the day's discoveries in the heart of the jungle.

DAY 7 - Monday | 1st February 2027

Meals: Breakfast Lunch Dinner

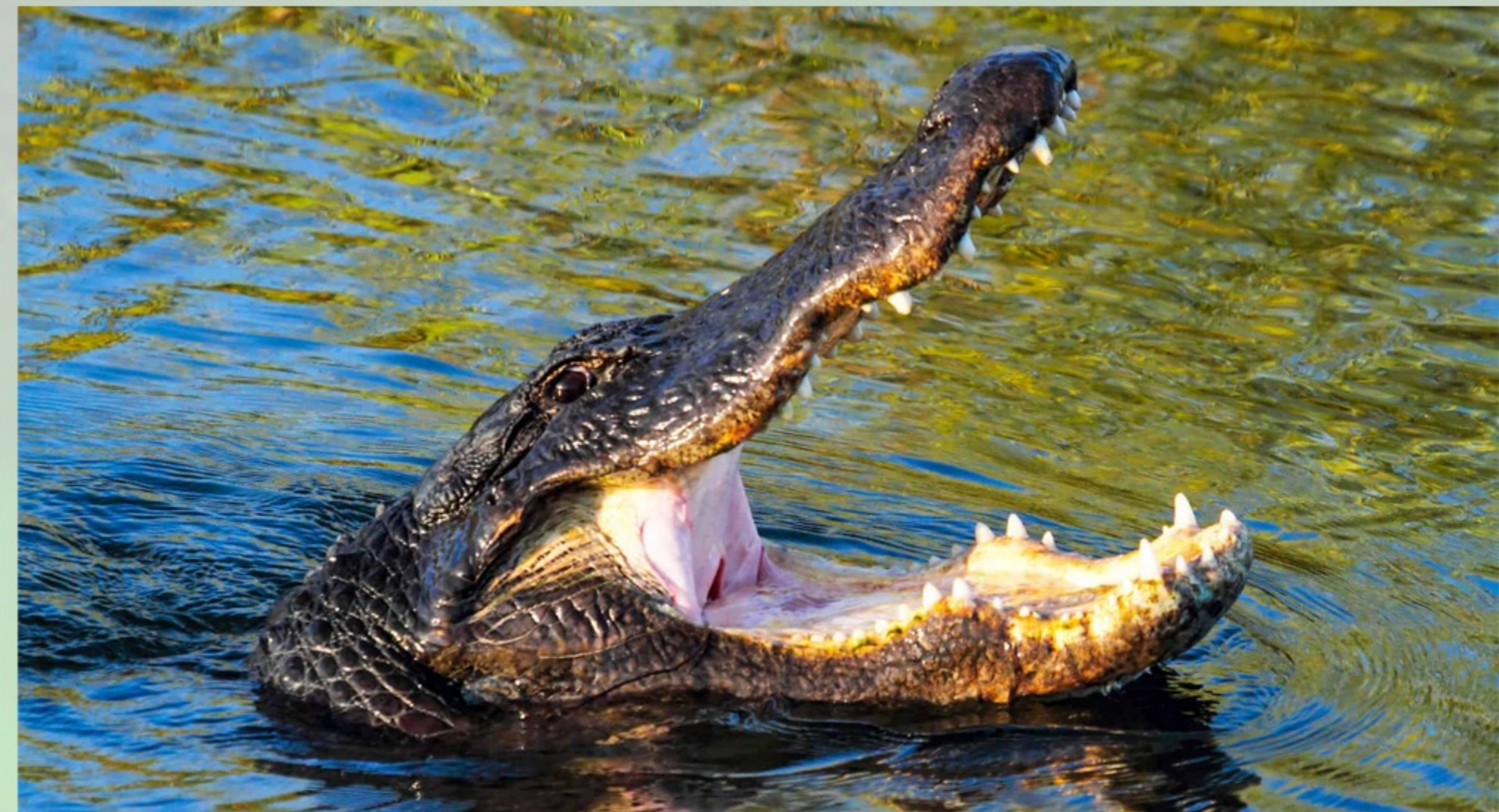
Activities: Jungle Trails & Alligator Night Encounters

After breakfast, we venture deeper into the wild with a guided jungle trek, where you'll learn about Amazonian plants, wildlife and survival skills used by the locals. After returning to the lodge for lunch, we head out again to explore the life of the forest's people.

We visit a traditional "Casa de Caboclos", where you'll see how locals live, work, and produce mandioca - a staple of Amazonian cuisine. From there, we explore a nearby village, where you'll encounter small plantations of tucumã, cupuaçu and other native fruits, as well as beautiful Amazonian handcrafts.

After dinner, the jungle reveals a different face as we head out on a nighttime boat ride in search of alligators. With only a flashlight and the sounds of the forest around you, it's an unforgettable glimpse into the nocturnal side of the Amazon.

DAY 8 - Tuesday | 2nd February 2027

Meals: Breakfast ✓ Lunch ✓ Dinner ✓

Activities: Monkey Jungle and Caboclo's House

Departure from the lodge by motorized canoe to the Center for Rehabilitation and Reintroduction of Wild Animals, known as the "Forest of the Monkeys". Here, feeding sessions take place twice daily, where the animals receive nutritional supplements alongside the food they naturally find in the forest. Visitors, always accompanied by qualified professionals, can film and photograph the animals in a totally natural and safe environment.

In the afternoon, discover the customs and traditions of the Amazon's riverside inhabitants, known as Caboclos, during a visit to an authentic local home. See examples of daily life, including the cassava plantation and the process of producing flour from the root, a staple of the regional diet. You will also learn about the rubber smoking process, where liquid latex extracted from rubber trees is transformed into solid rubber, as well as medicinal herbs commonly used for various treatments and stories about life along the Amazon riverbanks.

DAY 9 - Wednesday | 3rd February 2027

Meals: Breakfast ✓ Lunch ✓ Dinner ✓

Activities: Dolphins, Rivers & Indigenous Encounters

After breakfast, we say goodbye to the Amazon.

Departure from the pier sailing the waters of the Rio Negro River to the Pink Dolphin platform, where we swim with these friendly animals that are the symbol of the Amazon. Continue navigating to a community to enjoy a ritual with Indian dances and gestures where visitors are all invited to interact with the natives. We will continue the tour by navigating to Januari Ecological Park for a delicious regional lunch at a floating restaurant. After lunch, we will admire the curious meeting of the waters with a short stop to view this natural phenomenon and witness the thrilling "Pirarucu Attack", where the Amazon's largest fish bursts from the water in a powerful feeding display. A day full of natural wonder, cultural connection and wild beauty - the perfect finale to your rainforest adventure. We depart on an internal flight to Iguassu arriving late night.

DAY 10 - Thursday | 4th February 2027

Meals: Breakfast Lunch Dinner

Activities: Iguazu Falls – Up Close, All Around, and Right Through | Macuco Safari (Jungle + Boat)

Get ready for a day of pure natural wonder. We begin on the Argentine side of the falls, in Puerto Iguazú, where a network of walkways lets you experience the waterfalls from within. Wander through the lush Iguazú National Park, across trails that wind past dozens of cascades and through vibrant rainforest. Along the way, keep your eyes open for toucans, coatis, butterflies, and exotic flora.

3 main trails await, each offering a different perspective but we save the most dramatic for last: the walkway to the Garganta del Diablo (Devil's Throat). Standing at the edge of this roaring 90-meter drop, where 14 massive falls thunder into a single chasm, is a moment that will stay with you forever.

We break for lunch at El Fortin Restaurant, a scenic spot overlooking the river and the Brazilian side of the falls. Then we cross the border to explore a whole new side of the spectacle. The Brazilian trails offer sweeping, wide-angle views of the entire 4-kilometer-wide curtain of water - from above, below, and right in front of it. A leisurely 45-minute walk starting near the Belmond Hotel das Cataratas takes us along cliffs and balconies with breathtaking photo ops at every turn.

Then comes the adrenaline rush: the Macuco Safari. This guided experience begins with a ride through the jungle in an open electric vehicle, offering insight into the park's rich ecosystem. After a short forest walk, we reach the riverbank and board a powerful motorboat, heading straight into the mist and roar of Iguazu Falls. Expect to get soaked...and exhilarated. From quiet jungle paths to the thunder of crashing water, today is a full immersion into one of the planet's greatest natural spectacles.

DAY 11 - Friday | 5th February 2027

Activities: CIUDAD DEL ESTE - Border Crossing to Paraguay

This full-day excursion offers a combination of cultural highlights and shopping opportunities in Ciudad del Este, Paraguay's most famous commercial center. The tour departs in the morning, crossing the Friendship Bridge into Paraguay. Upon arrival, guests enjoy a panoramic city tour, learning about Ciudad del Este's role as a major commercial hub in South America and its multicultural atmosphere influenced by Paraguayan, Brazilian, Arab, and Asian communities. After the city tour, there is free time for shopping in the city's well-known commercial areas, where visitors can browse a wide variety of products such as electronics, perfumes, cosmetics, clothing, and souvenirs. The guide provides orientation on shopping areas, currency exchange, and border procedures. In the afternoon, the tour returns to Brazil, completing a dynamic and informative cross-border experience.

Get ready for an unforgettable day and night filled with spectacular views and vibrant celebration!

Once at the top, an escalator & elevator will take you to the base of the majestic Christ the Redeemer statue. From this incredible viewpoint (over 700m above sea level), enjoy sweeping views of Copacabana, Ipanema and Leblon beaches, the lagoon, Flamengo Stadium and Niterói Bridge.

As always during Carnival, expect long lines, but the festive atmosphere, filled with samba beats and good humour, makes the experience even more memorable!
