INTRODUCTION | VIGO - SANTIAGO DE COMPOSTELA

DAY 1 - Sunday | 6th September 2026

MALTA - Porto

- 04:30hrs - Meeting at MIA departures hall
- 06:30hrs - Flight to Porto
- 08:50hrs - ETA at Porto Airport
- 09:15hrs - 2hrs Transfer to Vigo
- 11:15hrs - Hotel check-in
- Free Evening in Vigo

This itinerary follows the final section of the Camino Portugués from Vigo to Santiago de Compostela, a well-marked 100 km route that typically takes 5–6 days to complete. Starting along Vigo's scenic coastline, the path joins the official Variante Espiritual/Coastal connections before continuing through Redondela, Pontevedra, Caldas de Reis and Padrón. Along the way, you'll experience a mix of peaceful forest trails, historic towns, Roman bridges, thermal springs, and traditional Galician cuisine. This stretch is ideal for walkers seeking a manageable distance with plenty of services, comfortable stages, and the satisfaction of arriving in Santiago with a Compostela certificate.



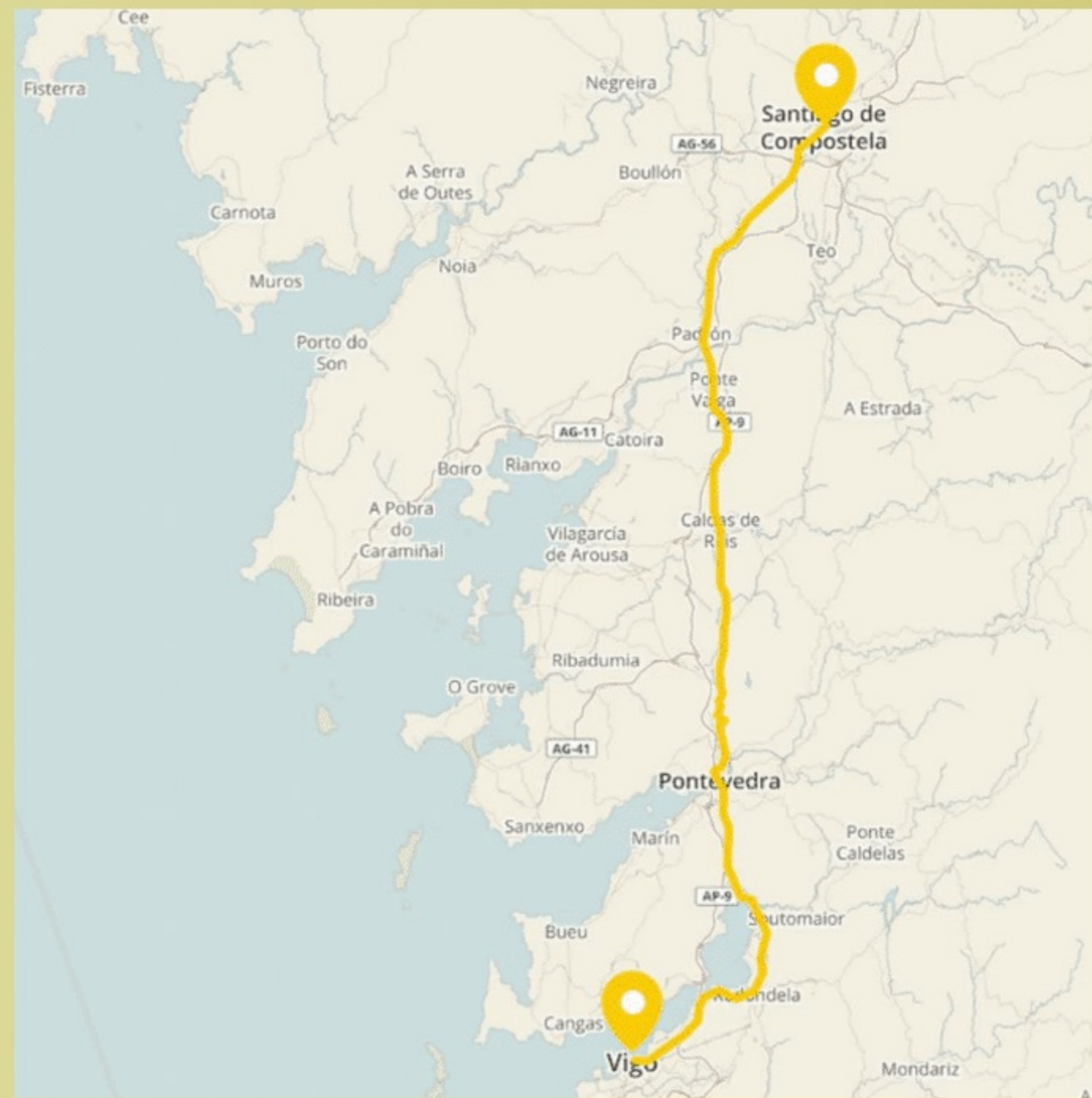

DAY 2 - Monday | 7th September 2026

VIGO - REDONDELA

- Start trekking 16km to Redondela
- Check-in at accommodation

A gentle first day that begins by following Vigo's waterfront promenade before climbing gradually into quieter residential areas and forest paths. The route offers beautiful views over the Ría de Vigo and the Cíes Islands on clear days. The final stretch descends into Redondela, known for its two impressive railway viaducts and as the point where the Coastal and Central Caminos merge. Plenty of services and cafés along the way make this stage very accessible.



DAY 3 - Tuesday | 8th September 2026

REDONDELA - PONTEVEDRA

- Start trekking 19km to Pontevedra
- Hotel check-in

A scenic and varied stage that leads you through forests, small hamlets and stretches of old stone paths. After passing through Arcade (famous for its oysters) you cross the historic Pontesampaio bridge, where the Camino enters more rural terrain. The final kilometers approach Pontevedra along shaded trails. Pontevedra's charming old town is one of the most beautiful on the Camino, with the iconic pilgrim-shaped Church of the Virxe da Peregrina.



DAY 4 - Wednesday | 9th September '26

PONTEVEDRA - CALDAS DE REIS

- Start trekking 22km to Caldas de Reis
- Hotel Check-in

A peaceful day mostly through woodland and vineyards, with long stretches on soft forest tracks. This is often considered one of the most relaxing stages for its natural beauty and quiet hamlets. Caldas de Reis welcomes pilgrims with its famous thermal waters, perfect for a foot soak after the day's walk. The town is small but offers good accommodation and dining options.



DAY 5 - Thursday | 10th September '26

CALDAS DE REIS - PADRON

- Start trekking 18km to Padron
- Hotel Check-in

A pleasant mix of riverbank paths, forest sections and small villages. The climb to O Pino is gentle, followed by a descent into the green valley leading toward Padrón. Rich in Jacobean legend, Padrón is the town where St. James's remains were said to have arrived by boat. Its historic center, markets and riverside walk make it a memorable stop before the final push.



DAY 6 - Friday | 11th September 2026

PADRON - SANTIAGO DE COMPOSTELA

- Start trekking 24km to Compostela
- Arrive at the Compostela Cathedral
- Completion Certificate
- Hotel check-in
- 20:00hrs - "Last Stamp" Completion dinner Celebration

The final stage begins on rural paths and gradually becomes more urban as you approach Santiago. After passing through the hamlet of A Escravitude and the parks of O Milladoiro, anticipation grows during the final approach. The last kilometers lead through the outskirts and into the historic center, culminating at the Praza do Obradoiro and the Cathedral of Santiago.

Reaching the square is an emotional and unforgettable moment for many pilgrims.



DAY 7 - Saturday | 12th September '26

SANTIAGO DE COMPOSTELA

- 07:30hrs - Breakfast

After breakfast one can choose to stay relax and discover Santiago de Compostela and if you are lucky, you will experience the special service with the use of the "Botafumeiro" to honor the pilgrims who have completed the Camino de Santiago.

OR - Take optional excursions:

- 09:45hrs | Duration 9.5 hours

Tour of Rias Baixas w/Boat trip and Winery

Discover the Rias Baixas and explore wonderful sea sites, islands, and towns. Take a boat ride through Galician estuaries with an endless amount of fresh mussels and wine.

- 08:45hrs | Duration 9.5 hours

Tour of Finisterre, Muxia & Costa da Morte

Combine nature and culture on this day trip from Santiago de Compostela to Costa da Morte and Muxia. See lighthouses, traditional villages, waterfalls, and Cape Finisterre on a 7-stop excursion.



DAY 8 - Sunday | 13th September 2026

SANTIAGO DE COMPOSTELA - MALTA

- 05:30hrs - Transfer to Porto airport
- 07:45hrs - Arrival at Porto airport
- 09:25hrs - Flight to Malta
- 13:20hrs - ETA at Malta Airport
